Locally sourced and produced in Scotland

We have two facilities at our South Lanarkshire site where we create quality compost. Firstly, we recycle locally sourced green and food waste in an in-vessel composting system (IVC) and secondly, we process pure green waste, both producing high grade compost certified to BSI PAS100.

Our green waste and food derived compost produced in an in-vessel composting (IVC) system has an additional maturation stage. This four-stage organic process can take up to 12 weeks and is carefully managed to ensure nutrient and organic matter retention.
